CMS Recognition Luncheon

- The recognition luncheon went well.
- All team members appreciated the recognition and the lunch.

FS 9.0 Upgrade–RFP-11/13/07

- The Finance 9.0 RFP was sent out on 11/13/2007.
- It was sent to three consultant companies: IBM, Cedar and Io Consulting.
- A response is expected on 12/06/2007.
- Actual work on this project will begin July 2008.

CMS – TA's 102/103

- The trailers are still being used.
- Everyone will move out the trailers by the end of December.
- The furniture will be distributed in January 2008.
- The trailers will be vacant by the end of January.

SA Implementation Topics

- Enrollment Reporting
 - There have been some anomalies in enrollment numbers.
 - Administrative Computing Services and Admissions are working together to solve the anomalies; a follow-up will be given in December.
 - They are looking at how data is interpreted in PeopleSoft compared to how data is interpreted in SIS+.
 - The differences between the two registration systems will be compiled in order to come up with a model.
- Navigation Improvements
 - MyCoyote labeling has been changed to help students learn the system.
 - The appearance has been changed to be more user friendly.
- Follow Up on Lessons Learned
 - Several departments are looking at and documenting what has been learned during the upgrade project to prevent repeating the past.
- Service Indicators
 - About 7,000 students have service indicators (holds).
 - These students are not able to register for winter.
 - It was suggested that the decision making process/policies for pre-requisitions be looked at.
 - It was suggested that Kim and Dwan take a look at how departments do pre-requisition checking.
 - The departments can be asked to document their procedures for pre-req checking.

HCM 8.9 Projects

- Three modules are working on post implementation projects.
- Temp faculty will be bundled in with the RFP for Finance 9.0.
- CMS Central will be meeting to discuss Benefits Administration.

Hyperion Contract – Brio Query and Data Warehouse

- The Hyperion Contract was handed out.
- The Brio product allows us to do queries.
- Hyperion was bought out by Oracle and they are re-bundling the product.
- A new contract was sent to the Chancellor's Office and the price has increased.
- This product is used on our campus.
- Our campus will not use this product until the Data Warehouse is up and running.
- Our campus will hold off on buying into the contract until the product is needed.

EC Council Meeting – 12/4/07

- Our campus will be hosting the EC Council Meeting on December 4th.
- There will also be a Cabo Meeting on our campus.

Discussion
